Hi Michael,

This can be done with writing plugin code, if you're up to it. The plugin has two extension points - the one you'll want to use is JiraOperationExtension. All of the operations implement this, and you can add your own.

we are using your plugin to set JIRA issues to the status "Live" when they get deployed. We often have the case where the status has been set manually before. In such cases it would be great, if there was a way to prevent the plugin to trigger the transition again, if the Before status and After status are the same.
