We are big fans of TAP plugins – thanks a lot for great piece of code!

We just upgraded TAP plugin from 20 to 22 and Jenkins from 611 to 615 and it fails on TAP now:

It seems that TAP plugin or newer jenkins (615, we used 611 before upgrade that all worked fine) – the TAP fails on # SKIP tag.

When we disable TAP plugin – all works fine and passes.
